Reference-Portfolio Guidelines

IFS Systematic Equity Income Strategy Basket

IFS Systematic Equity Income Strategy Basket (the "**Reference-Portfolio**") is a notional Swiss Franc ("CHF") denominated actively managed Reference-Portfolio, created and maintained by IFS Independent Financial Services AG (the "**Reference-Portfolio Advisor**"). The Reference-Portfolio aims to replicate (i) the performance of a basket of listed options ("each a "**Constituent**" and together the "**Equity Position**" or "**Constituents**"), and (ii) from time to time, a cash position (the "**Cash Position**", which together with the Constituents shall be referred to as the "**Reference-Portfolio Components**"), less fees and costs. No interest will be paid on the Cash Position. The Reference-Portfolio Components are selected by the Reference-Portfolio Advisor in accordance with the following guidelines (the "Reference-Portfolio Guidelines"):

1. Only listed options (the "Investment Universe") with sufficient liquidity may be incorporated as Reference-Portfolio Constituents in the Reference-Portfolio
 - a. vanilla puts (short position)
 - b. call-spreads (short position)
 - c. put-spreads (short position)
2. Investable universe will be stocks & indices in Europe & US
 - a. Stoxx 600 (BBG-Code: SXXP)
 - b. S&P 500 (BBG-Code: SPX)
3. At any time, the Total Exposure in the Equity Positions needs to be covered by cash in the basket. The Total Exposure is defined as the sum of short put strike notional and the difference of upper strike notional minus lower strike notional for call and put spreads
4. No interest will be paid on the Cash Position of the Reference-Portfolio

In case of a rebalancing the theoretical volume of a buy or sell order for a Constituent is limited to 200% of the average traded daily volume of that Constituent. A rebalancing may happen at the discretion of the Reference-Portfolio Advisor. The theoretical volume is defined as the number of outstanding Certificates multiplied by the Reference-Portfolio Level (using a reasonable foreign exchange rate to convert into the currency of the Constituent) and multiplied by the change in the percentage weight of the Constituent. The average traded daily volume is defined as the 30 Day average trading turnover. The expected number of Rebalancings per year is 35.

At any time, the Reference-Portfolio may reflect a Cash Position which mirrors the holding of cash (the "Cash Position").
